RE: Summer School Registration

Horizon Middle School will be offering summer school as a project based learning opportunity for incoming 7th & 8th grade students. The Summer Academic Program is a free four-week middle school summer program that focuses on reading, English, math, social studies, and science. This program will use a hands-on, project based approach to actively involve students.

- The project will begin on **Monday, June 6, and end on Thursday, June 30.**
- Classes will run **Monday through Thursday from 8:00am to 12:00pm.**
- Students need to complete 60 hours of class time.
- **Attendance is mandatory, due to state funding requirements** – students need to commit to the entire session.
- Class size is limited to a maximum of 15 students per teacher; therefore, enrollment will be on a first come, first serve basis.
- Busing service is not provided for the summer program. Due to limited funding, there is no supervision for your child before 8:00am or after 12:00pm.
- During the month of the project, students will receive small group instruction in core education areas.
- Students **may choose** to continue with math and reading remediation from Monday, July 11th through Thursday, July 21, 8:00am-11:45am.
