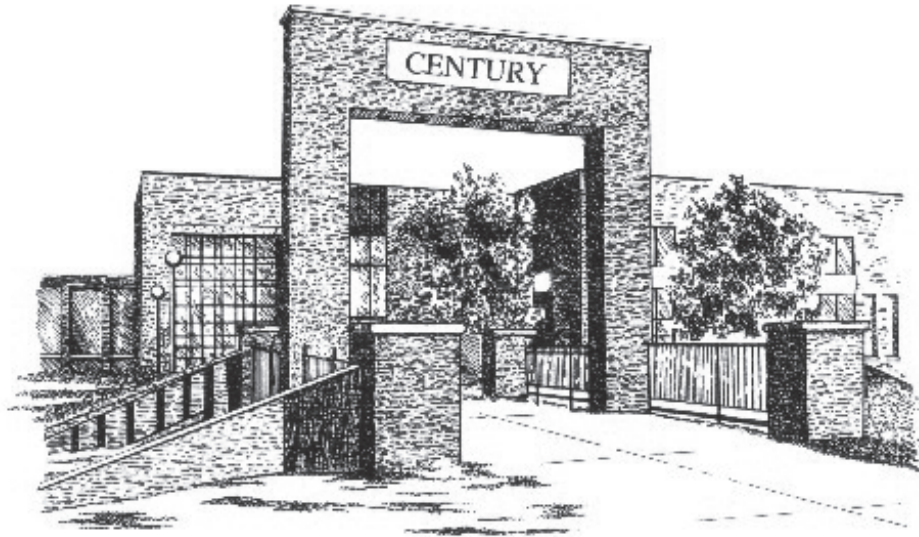

Valedictorians have achieved a grade-point average of 4.0 during Grades 9, 10, 11, and the first semester of Grade 12.

- These students wear a gold braid for the commencement ceremony and lead in the graduating class.

Students of Distinction have achieved a grade-point average of 3.75 or higher on a 4.0 scale during Grades 9, 10, 11, and the first semester of Grade 12.

- These students wear a blue and white braid and are seated directly behind the valedictorians.

\* = Recipients of the President's Education Award are individuals who achieved a 3.5 grade-point average or higher and ranked in the 85th percentile or higher in a math or reading standardized achievement test.

^ = Students honored with membership in the National Honor Society are individuals who achieved a cumulative grade-point average of 3.5 or higher and have met the requirements of 15 hours of community service and involvement in an activity or work.
