

# Wachter Middle School Girl's 6th Grade Soccer

*Welcome parents and players to the beginning of the 2024 girl's 6th grade soccer season!*

## **Practices and Games:**

The girls' season begins March 18th and ends May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Games will be played on Saturdays and two Tuesdays at the Cottonwood complex (see below). Each team will play 6 games and will have one jamboree where they play two or three 20-minute games. Practices are held twice each week at Wachter.

**Practices will be every Monday and Thursday from 3:30 - 4:30 pm on the Wachter field (south of school) unless we need to practice inside then it will be held in the EAST gym. Girls should be prepared to practice both indoors and outdoors each practice.**

*Please make arrangements to pick up your player on time.*

If a player is unable to make a practice or a game, they will need to contact their coach or Mrs. Healy. Communication is KEY!

## **Requirements/Equipment/Fees:**

1. Each player needs to pay a \$20 participation fee prior to the first competition (Mypayments Plus). They also need to register online. See Wachter athletic page for registration link. This needs to be completed online.
2. Each player will receive a jersey for the games. These shirts will be able to be used for other 6<sup>th</sup> grade sports. To complete their uniform players, need black shorts and black socks.
3. Athletes are to bring shin guards, cleats and/or running shoes, water bottle and a ball (optional) to practice. Players should be dressed for the weather. We may be in the gym for inclement weather.
4. We will use the **REMIND app** for communication this year. See back side of this page on how to join our class.
5. All jewelry must be removed before practice and games.

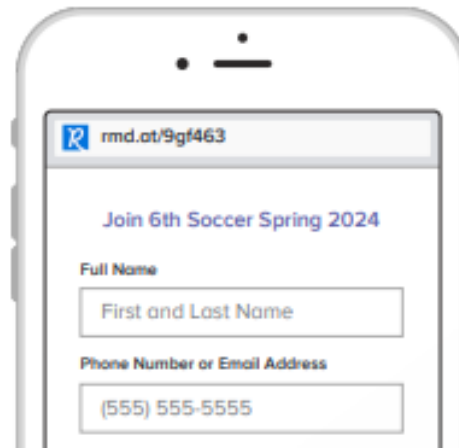
