#### **BMX Racing**


Location: Cottonwood Park S. 12th S Bismarck, ND


## 2024 Spring Bismarck Demon's 3 on 3 Basketball Tournament

#### **VCSU MBB 3 on 3 Tournament**





## Spring High School Clay Target League Sign-Up now Open

Registration for all six Bismarck-Mandan High School Clay Target League teams competing in the 2024 Spring North Dakota State High School Clay Target League (ND CTL) is now open. The spring season consists of eight weeks: orientation/optional practice week, practice week, a reserve week, and five weeks of league competition on Sunday afternoons (excluding Easter) from Mar. 24th to May 19th. Participants from all six Bis-Man middle and high schools in grades 6-12 with hunter's education may register by logging on

Participants can join one or all of four shooting sports disciplines: trap, skeet, 5-stand or sporting clays. Skeet, 5-stand and sporting clays will be logged at Capital City Sporting Clays located ten miles east of Bismarck on 71st Ave NE. Trap is capped at 240 participants. Registration will be open until 5pm sharp on Monday March 11th or until any caps have been met.

The Spring 2024 season cost for trap is \$350.00 via credit card online and \$35.00 by credit card online to the ND CTL for league registration at a later date. Costs cover all shells and targets for the entire spring season and include a team jersey.
